

 - Proposal Designation: **20241221-OS-02-01** (document was attached to the meeting agenda and the proposal DRAFT was also emailed with the agenda for all GA members to review before the meeting)
 - **The Michigan Assembly Reconciliation Process** - Debra Ann read the proposal to the GA and questions and comments followed. The Ombudsman Service is for conflict resolution for all Americans, including family members or relatives, not just GA members. It is overseen by the MAA and GA as a whole. The 83 counties will eventually develop their own ombudsman services, but they will need to be trained by the GA Ombudsman. Document is ready for proofreading before vote (Recording 01:15:15)

- General Assembly members are marked with an asterisk (*) before their name. Everyone else is a guest. Guests are welcome to observe but shall refrain from speaking and text chatting during these proceedings. An Outreach invitation will be offered at the end of the meeting.

- 1st Offense - Marshal at Arms will mute your microphone and give a warning.
- 2nd Offense - Marshal at Arms will mute your microphone and disable your video. You will not be acknowledged to speak for the remainder of the meeting.
- 3rd Offense - Marshal at Arms will remove you from the meeting.
