### Coordinator Updates (recording 00:52:10)

- **Public Service Announcement on our website.** Reports about FEMA. Distinction between The Michigan Assembly and other assemblies or groups. Ensuring we are not connected in anybody's mind with other Militia groups. This will remain on the front page of the website for a few more days, then will be moved to the Public Notices Section.
- **Regarding Militias.** Two people have reached out to Amy via the TASA contact form with the same request, which was to record their Common Carry Declaration. Neither of these men have corrected their status as far as The Michigan Assembly is concerned (nothing on LRO). We have to be vigilant in all areas and this is a big one. We do not record any paperwork, documents, notices independent of status correction paperwork.
- We had a successful test of an **assembly Emergency Plan**. We learned a whole lot including improvements needed. We will continue to work on this plan in committee or special session.
- A woman in our assembly has taken it upon herself to send out the **sheriff notices** to all 83 sheriffs on Michigan. Thank you Linda Johnson! She is going above and beyond by sending three separate mailings. The first and second have already been mailed. The third is upcoming.
