



International Technology Sharing Treaty

Whereas we stand stronger together and benefit from multiple perspectives, _____
and The Texas Assembly do hereby agree to the following standards regarding the sharing of
technological frameworks and tools.

This agreement pertains to technologies, strategies, and source code. It does not provide for the
sharing of data. Should data be inadvertently or necessarily exposed during collaboration, such data
shall be held in the strictest confidence. The nature and extent of the exposure shall be
communicated promptly and remedied with all due diligence. We stand together to guard and protect
one another's data.

The intent of this document is to formalize the spirit of our technological agreement between our
Assemblies. We wish to know what you are building, how you are building it, and, in the spirit of
reciprocity, we gladly offer our solutions and frameworks in return.

This agreement shall be managed by the heads of our respective Information Technology Committees,
remains open to amendment, modification or alteration as needs arise, with the full knowledge and
consent of our Citizens in the General Assembly.

This treaty is entered into between American State Citizens and stands as a Free Trade agreement. It
is not a value-for-value exchange, as each party may carry knowledge the other does not. That which
is shared - whether great or small - may yield blessings on either side, beyond measure.
