Militia Assembly Working Group (MAWG)

International Business Assembly Working Group (IBAWG)

- Summary: Two proposals are on the agenda for later in the meeting. Next meeting: Wednesday June 17th at 4pm. (Recording 00:24:40)

- Family Reunion: Dolores mentioned this above during Events/Outreach. Link to sign up provided there. There is also an announcement on The Michigan Assembly member-only website.
- Coordinator vetting by Continental Marshals: Rick is pursuing his vetting as Coordinator with the Continental Marshals (CM). He plans to discuss with The Michigan Assembly's Vetting Committee the process the CM's follow now. It's been simplified from how they were doing it back in 2024 when The Michigan Assembly 4.0 was starting.

In Process Items

- **Elections for Court Roles** (Nigel Turtle, JA Working Group)
 - Vetting continues for the Coroner, Justice and Bondsman. Rene McGuigan has volunteered to be considered for Court Clerk Pro Tem. She is currently assisting with the Ohio court documents. Still looking for volunteers for other court roles needing to be filled. Several roles need filled. Please email Nigel Turtle if interested. (Recording 00:28:25)
- **Elections for General Assembly Roles** (Rick Worden, Coordinator)
 - Marshal At Arms: Bob (troy) Brown completed his training. Having passed his vetting with the Continental Marshals he is now The Michigan Assembly's Marshal At Arms Pro Tem. Congratulations Bob and thank you!
 - Assembly Militia Coordinator: Fred Minamyers vetting is in process. The reason for pursuing this process is so Fred can more readily obtain educational materials from other state militias. The role is still being discussed in the GA Working Group.
 - Oversight Committee document from The Ohio Assembly: Rick obtained a one-page document from Ohio's Oversight Committee Chair on Saturday. He will share it with the GA Working Group tomorrow. (Recording 00:32:12)
- **Coordinator Team** (GA Working Group)
 - Proposal Designation: **GA-20260023** [Time stamp 00:34:50]
 - *Shall The Michigan Assembly rescind the one coordinator limit and the coordinator contingency plan and ask for volunteers to be additional coordinators so that there is a team to work together in building the four Pillars?*
 - Still in committee. It's not been discussed in recent weeks because other topics have displaced it on the agenda. Anyone interested in this proposal please come to the meeting to contribute.

In Process Items (continued)

- **Adoption of “Good Standing Procedure” and “Committee Membership and Voting Members”** (GA Working Group) [Time stamp 00:35:30]
 - Proposal Designation: **GA-20260029**
 - *Shall The Michigan Assembly adopt these two documents: “Good Standing Procedure” and “Committee Membership and Voting Members”?*
 - Still in committee. These documents came from Ohio. The “Good Standing Procedure” has been reviewed in committee. The other document has not been looked at yet.

New Items

- **Provisional Document Status** (GA Working Group)
 - Proposal Designation: **GA-20260033** [Time stamp 00:36:25]
 - *Shall the General Assembly create a guideline document **status** called “Provisional” to indicate acceptance of a specific document for ongoing use and practice during development and modification?*
 - Rick Worden introduced this proposal by first showing the GA where the “current guidelines” are kept on the Assembly’s member-only website. Current status options are “GA approved”, “Work in progress”, or “Pending”. This proposal will provide a “Provisional” status for documents received from The Ohio Assembly, for example, that we want to implement now but can still make changes as we go along and learn. This way, the GA is seeing the documents sooner rather than later. This is a structural procedural step to help us towards standing, seatment and governing.
 - Discussion followed, please listen to the recording for details.
 - The documents we are putting together are for use five years down the road when The Michigan Assembly will be seated and governing. These are foundational documents with many eyes on them already including the Federation. The Provost Marshal has said that Ohio and Tennessee are doing everything correctly so why wouldn’t we want to follow?
- **International Business Assembly Roles and Elections** (IBA Working Group)
 - Proposal Designation: **IBA-20260030** [Time stamp 01:21:45]
 - *Shall The Michigan Assembly adopt the “Roles and Elections” document for the International Business Assembly?*
 - These documents are originally from Ohio and still have a lot of work to do on them to make them for Michigan as the IBA works through the pillar details. The IBA was unaware of the “provisional” status proposal from the GAWG when they wrote up this proposal, but that status, if approved by the GA, is appropriate for what the IBA is proposing with these documents.
 - Mark Steinke read the proposal to the GA members.
 - A PDF of the working document is under “current guidelines” on the Assembly member-only website under the IBA section. The editable document is under “Editable documents” for the IBA.
 - This document will be back in committee for further work on defining roles for the IBA.
- **International Business Assembly Committee Purposes** (IBA Working Group)
 - Proposal Designation: **IBA-20260031** [Time stamp 01:25:40]
 - *Shall The Michigan Assembly adopt the “Committee Purposes” document for the International Business Assembly?*
 - See comments above for the “Roles and Elections” document.
 - This document will be back in committee for further work on defining committee purposes for the IBA.
- **Michigan Assembly Digital Monthly Newsletter** (Education, Events and Outreach)
 - Proposal Designation: **GA-20260032** [Time stamp 01:39:35]
 - *Shall we use a Newsletter for Outreach?*
 - Dolores Rubio-Fernandez read the proposal to the GA. Discussion followed; some concern about ASNs not wanting to receive emails but Dolores explained they can “unsubscribe” if they want. The committee would like the GA to vote on this proposal tonight. There is a \$108 recurring annual expense for MailerLite.
 - [Time stamp 01:52:15] **VOTE:** “Do we want to vote on this proposal tonight?” Members voted with  (or thumb) or  via Zoom. **Results:** **13 YES 2 NO** (Brent Barth verbally said “Yes”. Screenshot taken and is included with the minutes).

New Items (continued)

- [Time stamp 02:00:25] Linda Steinke directed the Roll Call vote. Jan Buzard assisted with the vote tally on the screen. The GA waited for the results to be reported.
- **RESULTS: YES = 15 NO = 2 PASSED** [1 Present, 39 Absent]
- **Vote on the Militia pillar logo** (Militia Assembly Working Group)
 - [Time stamp 02:08:55]
 - Richard Saroni shared the four original designs that have been on the Assembly member-only website and also part of a survey on Telegram. Additional designs were also shared. He provided some information he found on costs for patches; simple = less cost.
 - Discussion followed. Several designs look great but are complicated with lots of colors. The purpose of the patches needs to be clearly defined.
 - The MAWG agreed during committee today that we would not be voting on these designs tonight.
 - This will go back to committee for continued discussions. The Militia Assembly Working Group will also review the survey results once they receive them.
