She is looking for homesteading and emergency response information to share with the group so we can develop educational material for the Militia pillar. The MAA raised a concern about people having access to these documents without proper vetting and affirmations. The Coordinator worked with Rene and Fred to access these documents; Fred has not yet obtained access. This will be discussed further at the MAWG meeting next week. New Items

- **Public Law Concerning Mercenary Warfare** (GA Working Group)
 - Proposal Designation: **GA-20260035** [Time stamp 01:15:00]
 - *Be it enacted and agreed and resolved throughout our fifty (50) physically-defined States of the Union and our similarly held Territories and Possessions, our Federal Enclaves, and our Extra-Territorial and Municipal Holdings throughout the world, that mercenary war for profit is unlawful, illegal, and immoral; we will not participate in mercenary conflicts ourselves nor aid those that do engage in war for profit.*
 - The proposal language was read to the General Assembly members in attendance.
 - These are considered “routine” and because Anna has indicated there may be some changes to the language, the GA will not be voting on them tonight.
- **Public Law Concerning the Naming of Business Entities** (GA Working Group)
 - Proposal Designation: **GA-20260036** [Time stamp 01:18:35]
 - *Be it enacted and agreed and resolved throughout our fifty (50) physically-defined States of the Union and our similarly held Territories and Possessions, our Federal Enclaves, and our Extra-Territorial and Municipal Holdings throughout the world, that the word “Unincorporated” shall be added to all doing-business-as names of our American Government and all unincorporated businesses that are associated with us and standing under American Law effective September 1st 2026.*
 - The proposal language was read to the General Assembly members in attendance.

New Items (continued)

- **Public Law Concerning Technological Intrusions and Pollution** (GA Working Group)
 - Proposal Designation: **GA-20260037** [Time stamp 01:19:55]
 - *Be it enacted and agreed and resolved throughout our fifty (50) physically-defined States of the Union and our similarly held Territories and Possessions, our Federal Enclaves, and our Extra-Territorial and Municipal Holdings throughout the world, that: (1) Invasive technologies that non-consensually access data, surveillance us, intrude upon our biological functions or otherwise violate our right to privacy are strictly prohibited; (2) Artificially induced electromagnetic fields and radiation in general are forms of pollution subject to our environmental quality standards; data centers, microwave towers, and similar installations must function safely in the Public Interest, or be shut down; (3) Aerial spraying of chemicals and particulate matter are forms of pollution subject to our environmental quality standards; any such activities must yield a proven and substantial benefit in the Public Interest to be allowed; (4) The people of our nation-states are non-domestic with respect to the citizenry of the United States and the inhabitants of our Territories and Possessions and cannot be subjected to weapons testing or other experiments under the ENMOD Treaties or similar international conventions that allow such testing on domestic populations. (5) All foreign and domestic corporations, service vendors, and agency contractors are required to take notice and comply with items (1) through (4) above.*
 - The proposal language was read to the General Assembly members in attendance.
- **Public Law Concerning Involuntary Servitude, Conscription and Press-Ganging** (GA Working Group)
 - Proposal Designation: **GA-20260038** [Time stamp 01:22:24]
 - *Be it enacted and agreed and resolved throughout our fifty (50) physically-defined States of the Union and our similarly held Territories and Possessions, our Federal Enclaves, and our Extra-Territorial and Municipal Holdings throughout the world, that: peonage, forced conscription and press-ganging are repugnant and unlawful, illegal, and immoral and will not be imposed upon any American living in the physically-defined States of the Union nor any American Person nor any citizen of the United States nor any U.S. Citizen, guest, or asylum seeker.*
 - The proposal language was read to the General Assembly members in attendance.
 - These are considered “routine” and because Anna has indicated there may be some changes to the language, the GA will not be voting on them tonight. The GA Working Group can discuss tomorrow how we want to proceed.
- **Other New Business** [Time stamp 01:40:25]
 - This is a new item and the Coordinator sent out an email this past week introducing it to the Assembly. The GA Working Group agreed this is something that needs to be added to the agenda. Members can bring up items, we won’t get into a long debate, but the GA may decide to send it to committee.
 - Rene McGuigan requested that we adopt the Ohio documents as they are and use them as working documents now. Rick Worden replied that this is the plan. Rene further explained that we need to submit them to the Federation for approval, “like other states have done”, and “check this off our list”. This has not been requested directly by Anna. The Ohio Assembly continues to update their documents even though they had public elections in July 2024, are standing and recently became “seated”. Further discussion drifted to topics of concern including the continued “in fighting” within the assembly that may be keeping good men and women from joining and doing the work. Roles including Ombudsman and Oversight need filled. The Marshal At Arms closed with the following: “there will be no more brush fires and disruptions in The Michigan Assembly without dispute resolution. If you are causing problems among other members its disrespectful. We are all here for the common good and we are coming together to create something. All this other stuff and this in-fighting its gotta stop. Period.”
 - The meeting was closed for the evening.
